SAV offers free driving evaluation

The Green Valley Sheriff's Auxiliary Volunteers are teaming up with AAA in offering drivers a new self-evaluation tool, a computer program that aids senior citizens in assessing their driving ability.

The program is NOT connected to ADOT's Motor Vehicle Division or the Sheriff's Department. It is meant to increase the driver's OWN awareness of his or her driving abilities.

The computer program is interactive and easy to use. It evaluates eight areas of a person's physical and mental abilities that have been identified as crash risk predictors. The eight screening tests take about 40 minutes combined. Upon completion, the program rates the driver's level of skill and recommends any additional action for those with "serious" crash risk.

Some of the screens are similar to simple video games, and the whole program is guided by a narrated video tutorial as well as written instructions. A SAV facilitator will also be on hand to assist with the computer.

SAV is hoping that drivers will look for ways to improve their skills as a result of this program's evaluations.
