HOME EMERGENCY PROTECTION FROM WATER AND SEWER LINE BREAKS

Many homeowners are not aware that they own their water service line-and will have to pay for any repairs out of pocket. The exterior water service line from your property boundary to the water service meter is your responsibility. With the age of the homes in our HOA we have seen homes recently needing to pay for these expensive repairs, and at times having to replace the driveway if the water lines run underneath.

There is an independent company recommended by the Green Valley Council called Service Line Warranties of America. They provide emergency home repair services and protection to homeowners across the U.S. Green Valley Council has endorsed this company for many years as they have an A+ rating with the BBB and provide a much-needed service for many homes in Green Valley.

The plan for water line protection is only \$4.33 a month. This is an excellent protection plan to have in case an emergency happens.
